REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY

1. **AGE REQUIREMENT:** Students must be 15 years old by April 19, 2010.
2. **PARENT/STUDENT MANDATORY ORIENTATION:** (You may attend either one)

THS: 6:30-7:30 PM, Wednesday, April 14th in the Library.
BHHS: 6:30-7:30 PM, Thursday, April 15th in the Commons.
3. **DRIVE PRACTICE:** You should have the time and resources to provide your student with a minimum of two to three hours of drive practice per week. If not, consider signing the student up for the summer course. This will help ensure your student is successful.
4. **DRIVER'S PERMITS:** Students will be expected to pick up the Permit Application form at the ASB office prior to Spring Break, April 1st or 2d. However, you cannot take the form to DOL prior to the 9th of April. DOL will only issue permits within 10 days of the start date of the class. The student must fill out the top portion before leaving the ASB window. This will allow the student to receive their Learner's Permit without having to take the written test. The cost is \$20 paid at DOL. Preferably two forms of identification are required. This information can be found at the DOL web Site: www.dol.wa.gov. Remember to check office locations and times of operation. The Lacey office is extremely busy, you may want to consider the Shelton or Centralia locations.
5. **REGISTRATION FEES:** You must pay \$360 (cash or check only) to Mrs. Spriggs in the Financial Office (ASB) to register for the class. If a student withdraws during the first two class sessions a complete refund is given. Partial refunds are not given. In case of course failure, suspension, or expulsion no refund is given and the student must pay the entire fee again to re-enroll in another session.
6. **CLASSES:** Room A-35. Every Monday and Wednesday from 2:15 to 4:15, starting 19 April and ending 9 June 2010. There will be one makeup class on one of the last Fridays for any absences. There is no class or drives on non-school days. Classes on Early Release Wednesday will be from 12:15 to 2:15.
7. **DRIVES:** Students will sign up for a specific drive day and time. Drives will start the second week of the class. Drives times will be Monday through Friday, 2:15 to 4:15 and 4:15 to 6:15. There will be drives on Saturdays, 8:00 to 10:00, 10:00-12:00 and 12:30 to 2:30. There will be two students in the car, each will drive for one hour and observe for one hour. Students are required to pass six-one hour drive lessons.
