KEY IDEAS

- During **CLASS PERIODS** (105 minutes), students spend time with only that teacher
 - Daily attendance will be taken (more information on attendance will be communicated to families at a later date).
 - Asynchronous learning means = short (15-20 minute) videos teachers create guiding students through new learning experiences. Video can be stopped and started by students as learning progresses and be accessed through teacher Google Classroom.

- Synchronous learning means = Live zoom with teacher for purposes of expanding learning, social interaction with peers, group/small group/individual work with students.
- Independent learning (off-line) may also be utilized during class periods.
- Asynchronous and Synchronous sessions will be recorded by teachers for students who need to view/revisit class sessions at other times.
- Students whose home schedules may not allow for connection during the established schedule provided will need to connect with teachers for an alternate plan.
- Open Office Hours (Mon - Fri): Time set aside at the end of the day for students and/or parents to connect with teachers for additional support if needed.
 - Teachers, on their own, may set up other office hours outside of the schedule
- **WEDNESDAY SCHEDULE:**
 - No class periods will be scheduled on Wednesdays.
 - The goal for most work is to provide students with activities and projects that can be done off-line (Choice Boards).
 - Wednesday may be the day teachers ask students to do short periods of time on Moby Max or iReady
 - **HOMEROOM (1:15- 2:00):**
 - Students are expected to attend homeroom (only required time to attend on Wednesdays)
 - Attendance will be taken
 - Homeroom activities include: Social Connections with peers, Social Emotional Learning opportunities, NAVIANCE lessons (TSD 6-12 College and Career Readiness Curriculum), and other fun activities HR teachers may wish to lead.
 - Open Office Hours (Mon-Fri): Time set aside at the end of the day for students and/or parents to connect with teachers for additional support if needed..
 - Teachers will utilize email and phone calls as primary means for contacting parents/families.
