Beginning Friday, May 3, 2019:

A student will forfeit the right to attend the first year-end activity if his/her behavior results in any of the following:

- ☹ 3 MINORS
- ☹ Suspension of one or more days (out of school)

After the first activity is lost, each subsequent minor or office referral (Major) will result in another loss of an activity. Normally, students will lose reward activities in the order they are scheduled.
