



Tumwater School District Chromebook Fee Opt Out Form

Tumwater School District issues a student Chromebook to secondary sites that are participating in the one-to-one program for use for the academic year. Checking out Chromebooks to students supports equity in technology and standardizes the technology that best supports the curricula taught in TSD.

A \$25 yearly tech fee is annually assigned to student accounts that are not participating in the free and reduced lunch program. This fee covers the replacement cost of the device (\$250) if it is stolen and covers 100% of the repair costs the first time it is damaged. If the device is damaged a second time, the student account will be assessed a fee for 50% of the cost of repair. Subsequent damaged will be paid for at full price.

By opting out of the fee, families will assume complete responsibility for damage to the device. In the event that the device is stolen or damaged, please notify the school's librarian as soon as possible so the issue can be resolved quickly and another device can be checked out to your child. If you do not want the device to come home, please make arrangements with your school to find a location that your child can safely store the device at school.

If a parent or guardian does not wish their student to have a Chromebook, they must have a conversation with a building administrator. The form will be kept on file in the library and the fee removed from the district system.

This form must be submitted to your school's ASB office no later than Monday, September 30, 2019.

I am opting out of the Chromebook Fee and will pay all costs of repair and/or replacement.
