Tips for Applying



Applying for scholarships can be time consuming but think about your return on the investment.

- Most scholarships require an essay!
 - Make sure you save your essays.
- Keep a file or calendar of scholarships you qualify for, websites where to find them, and the timelines of all the due dates.
- If a scholarship asks you to pay for it, it's likely a scam! You shouldn't have to pay for free money.
