Kindergarten

Please bring these supplies with you when you come for your child's conference appointment at the beginning of school.

1. \$10.00 for Special Projects
2. 1 backpack labeled with child's name (no wheels)
3. 1 package of baby wipes
4. Large Elmer's glue sticks (6 or 8)
5. Large crayons – 1 pack (Not Jumbo)
6. 8 count Crayola crayons – 5 packs
7. Girls: Colored pencils
Gallon size Ziploc bags

Boys: 1 package Crayola thick markers
Sandwich size Ziploc bags
8. 2 boxes Ticonderoga Yellow #2 pencils
9. Hand sanitizer
10. Kleenex

Optional: Bottle of Elmer's School Glue

1st Grade

1. Headphones – 2 pairs (one for lab, one for classroom) preferably not earbuds - **Label**
2. 3 boxes of Crayola crayons (no more than 24 in a box, not florescent or scented)
Label each box with name
3. 1 **JUMBO** book cover
4. 1 pair of good quality pointed children's scissors (Fiskars) - **Label**
5. 1 hard plastic pencil box to hold supplies (approximately 8½" x 5" – no zipper pouches)
Label
6. 1 family size box Kleenex - **Label**
7. 2 packages (4) thin **BLACK** whiteboard markers (Expo brand is best)
8. 2 sets of thin Crayola markers – **Label box**
9. 2 packages of Crayola colored pencils (sharpened) – **Label each box**
10. 3 2-bottom pocket folders – **name on outside**
11. 1 spiral notebook- wide ruled-**Label front cover**
12. 6 Elmer's Jumbo gluesticks
13. 2 boxes Ticonderoga Yellow #2 pencils -
sharpen if possible
14. 1 roll paper towels
15. Flip top water bottle
16. 1 large bottle hand sanitizer
17. **A – N:** Sandwich size Ziploc bags
O – Z: Gallon size Ziploc bags

2nd Grade

1. 1 box of regular crayons (24)
2. 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars work well)
3. 2 dozen #2 pencils (Yellow Ticonderoga preferred)
4. 8 or 10 count markers-thick **classic colors**
5. 2 big pink erasers
6. 4 glue sticks
7. Water color paints
8. Small pencil box (please no locks)
9. 1 package of colored pencils (Twistables preferred)
10. 1 package of pencil top erasers
11. Inexpensive earbuds
12. 1 two pocket folder
13. 1 bottle hand sanitizer
14. Spiral notebook – wide-ruled
15. If your last name begins with:
A - N: Tissues
O - Z: Gallon Ziploc bags
or
Sandwich Ziploc bags

3rd Grade

1. #2 yellow pencils – 3 dozen (already sharpened if possible)
2. Dozen fine tip BLACK EXPO markers
3. Colored pencils – 12 count or 24 count
4. Crayons – 24 count
5. Markers – fine tip
6. Headphones
7. Scissors
8. Personal water bottle to refill at home and bring with your child each day
9. Personal pencil sharpener
10. 2 spiral notebooks-wide rule
11. Last Name:
A – L: Sandwich size Ziploc bags
M – Z: Gallon size Ziploc bags

4th Grade

1. 4 dozen #2 pencils
2. Student scissors
3. Colored pencils – any size
4. 3 spiral notebooks – single subject, wide-ruled
5. Pencil pouch or bag – **no boxes**
6. 8-pack markers
7. Earbuds/headphones
8. 3 packs of glue sticks
9. 4 fine-tip Black EXPO markers
10. 1 pack college-ruled notebook paper
11. 1 box of tissue
12. 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
13. 2 black Sharpie markers

5th Grade

1. 1 bottle Hand Sanitizer
2. 2 dozen #2 pencils, preferably sharpened
3. 1 pack of mechanical pencils w lead, .7, HB, #2
4. 1 pencil pouch, large enough to fit all supplies
5. 1 small pencil sharpener that fits in pencil pouch
6. 1 pack of large pink erasers
7. 1 pair of scissors
8. 1 box of colored pencils
9. 1 box or markers
10. 3 spiral notebooks
11. 2 lined paper Composition books
12. 1 graph paper Composition book
13. 2 large white glue sticks
14. 2 sets of earbuds or headphones (dollar store)
15. 2-pack of thin, multi-colored highlighters
16. 1 box of sealable sandwich bags
17. 1 box of tissue
18. 2 packs of post-it notes
19. Extra masks for your child's backpack

Please label everything with your child's first and last name. Earbuds need to be in a case or Ziploc bag, one pair will stay in Tech.
