Kindergarten

Please bring these supplies with you when you come for your child's conference appointment at the beginning of school.

1. \$10.00 for Special Projects
2. 1 backpack labeled with child's name (no wheels)
3. Large Elmer's glue sticks (6 or 8)
4. Large crayons – 1 pack (Not Jumbo)
5. 8 count Crayola crayons – 5 packs
6. Girls: Colored pencils
Gallon size Ziploc bags
Baby wipes

Boys: 1 package Crayola thick markers
Sandwich size Ziploc bags
Hand sanitizer
8. 2 boxes Ticonderoga Yellow #2 pencils
9. Kleenex

1st Grade

1. Headphones – 2 pairs (one for lab, one for classroom) preferably not earbuds - **Label**
2. 3 boxes of Crayola crayons (no more than 24 in a box, not florescent or scented)
Label each box with name
3. 1 **JUMBO** book cover
4. 1 pair of good quality pointed children's scissors (Fiskars) - **Label**
5. 1 hard plastic pencil box to hold supplies (approximately 8½" x 5" – no zipper pouches)
Label
6. 2 packages (4) thin **BLACK** whiteboard markers (Expo brand is best)
7. 2 sets of thin Crayola markers – **Label box**
8. 2 packages of Crayola colored pencils -
Label each box
9. 3 2-bottom pocket folders – **name on outside**
10. 1 spiral notebook- wide ruled-**Label front cover**
11. 6 Elmer's Jumbo glue sticks
12. 2 boxes Ticonderoga Yellow #2 pencils -
sharpen if possible
13. 1 roll paper towels
14. Flip top water bottle
15. 1 Wide ruled composition notebook - **Label**
16. 1 Crayola water colors

2nd Grade

1. 2 boxes of regular crayons (24)
2. 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars work well)
3. 2 dozen #2 pencils (Yellow Ticonderoga preferred)
4. 2 big pink erasers
5. 1 pack glue sticks – 4 or more
6. Water color paints (Crayola)
7. Small pencil box (please no locks)
8. 1 package of Twistables colored pencils
9. 1 package of pencil top erasers
10. Inexpensive earbuds/headphones
11. 1 bottle hand sanitizer (Purell or GermX)
12. Reusable water bottle with name
13. If your last name begins with:
A - N: Tissues
O - Z: Any size Ziploc bags

3rd Grade

1. #2 yellow pencils – 3 dozen
2. Pencil tip erasers
3. Dozen fine tip BLACK EXPO markers
4. Colored pencils – 12 count or 24 count
5. Crayons – 24 count
6. Markers – fine tip
7. Headphones
8. Scissors
9. Personal water bottle to refill at home and bring with your child each day
10. 1 spiral notebook (wide rule)
11. 1 composition book
11. Last Name:
A – L: Quart size Ziploc bags
M – Z: Gallon size Ziploc bags

Since storage space and desks are small, please do not send binders, folders, or pencil boxes.

4th Grade

1. 4 dozen #2 pencils
2. Student scissors
3. Colored pencils – any size
4. 3 spiral notebooks – single subject, wide-ruled
5. Pencil box/pencil pouch
6. 8-pack markers
7. Earbuds/headphones
8. 3 packs of glue sticks
9. 1 set of watercolors
10. 1 pack wide-ruled notebook paper
11. 2 black Sharpie markers
12. Last Name:
A – M: Box of tissues
N – Z: Bottle of hand sanitizer

Teachers will provide all folders needed.

5th Grade

1. 2 dozen #2 pencils, preferably sharpened
2. 1 pencil pouch, large enough to fit all supplies
3. 1 small pencil sharpener that fits in pencil pouch
4. 1 pack of large pink erasers
5. 1 pair of scissors
6. 1 box of colored pencils
7. 1 box of markers
8. 3 spiral notebooks
9. 2 lined paper Composition books
10. 4 – 8 large white glue sticks
11. 2 sets of earbuds or headphones (dollar store)
12. 2-pack of thin, multi-colored highlighters
13. 1 box of tissue
14. 2 packs of post-it notes

Optional: mechanical pencils with lead if preferred instead of regular pencils.

If possible, 1 roll of Scotch tape and 1 roll of masking tape for class use. Also, \$5.00 for special projects (cash) would be very helpful.

Earbuds need to be in a case or Ziploc bag, one pair will stay in Tech. (Please label earbuds/headphones with the child's first and last name.)
