4. Large Elmer's glue sticks (6 or 8)
5. Large crayons – 1 pack (Not Jumbo)
6. 8 count Crayola crayons – 5 packs
7. 1 pack of Ticonderoga #2 soft lead pencils (12 per box)

**1st Grade**

1. Headphones – 2 pairs (one for lab, one for classroom)
2. 3 boxes of regular crayons (no more than 24 in a box, not florescent or scented)

3. 1 **JUMBO** book cover
4. 1 pair of good quality pointed children's scissors (Fiskars) - **Label**
5. 1 plastic pencil box to hold supplies (approximately 8½" x 5" – no zipper pouches) **Label**
6. 1 box Kleenex
7. 2 packages (4) thin **BLACK** whiteboard markers (Expo brand is best)
8. 2 sets of thin Crayola markers – **Label**
9. 2 packages of colored pencils (sharpened) – **Label**
10. 3 2-bottom pocket folders – **name on the outside**
11. 1 spiral notebook – wide ruled – **Label**
12. Girls – regular glue sticks

### 3rd Grade

1. #2 yellow pencils – 3 dozen
2. 1 pack wide-rule line paper
3. 4 fine tip BLACK EXPO markers
4. Colored pencils – 12 count
5. Crayons – 24 count
6. Markers – fine tip
7. 3 packages pencil top erasers
8. Glue sticks
