



Student Assessment

An overview of **i-Ready**

i-Ready is taken by students in **grades two through eight** in both reading and math. This diagnostic assessment adapts in difficulty based on student responses to pinpoint where students need additional support. The test is aligned to state standards and comes with classroom resources to provide individualized instruction.

Format



The i-Ready assessments are completed online. Each child takes the assessment using a district login.

i-Ready adapts to each student, providing easier or harder questions depending on students' answers to previous questions. By adapting across grades K–12, i-Ready Diagnostic helps teachers understand the root causes behind student strengths and challenges.

Timeline



These assessments are taken by students three times during the school year.

The total amount of time per test is about 45 minutes. There is no time limit.

Results are available immediately. Teachers have access to both classroom and individual score reports.

Outcomes



Schools use data from these assessments place students in groups to receive instruction that is targeted to their individual needs.

We also use these assessments as part of a comprehensive program to identify how we allocate and use federal and state dollars to support student learning.
