

The **SKETCHBOOK** ASSIGNMENT

16 ways to earn points for your sketchbook work:

- 1) Your sketchbook is a **durable, well-bound book** (hardcover or spiral).
 - **not** a pad of gummed papers (that eventually fall out)
 - **not** a folder of loose papers/pages
 - **not** a stack of stapled or clipped papers
 - **not** a coloring book, etc. etc.
- 2) Your book is **no larger than 8x10 inches** and **no smaller than 4x6 inches**.
- 3) Put your **name** and other info clearly, neatly and permanently (artistically?) **ON the front cover** of your book.
- 4) **Dedicate** your book to just *this* semester and to just *this* course.
- 5) Make your book's pages contain **original work** made from your own photos, ideas, imagination, memories or observations – **not copied** from others' pictures, photographs, or artworks.
- 6) Your book's pages contain either...
 - A. the posted/displayed/announced "**DAILY SKETCH SUGGESTION**" or
 - B. a **particular topic of study, interest, aspiration or theme**.
- 7) Make each page in your sketchbook look like **30 minutes** (or more) of work.
- 8) **Do not use graphite** ("lead" or "lead pencil") on any of the pages.
- 9) Instead of graphite, **use a variety of other media** throughout the pages of your book.
- 10) Use just **one side of each page per artwork/sketch**.
- 11) Keep the **content/subject matter appropriate** for school and public display.
- 12) **Give each page a date** like a diary, making it easy for viewers to follow and chronicle your work.
- 13) **Use the pages in order** and **number each page** as you go, making it easy for viewers to follow.
- 14) Have the **assigned number of pages of artworks** in your book (by producing one each day).
- 15) **Attach** all loose pages, artifacts, etc., so **nothing falls out**. (Loose pages/items are not counted.)
- 16) Keep your book in **good condition** and **easy to look through**.

Scores earned at the final will *replace* scores earned at the midterm.

Scores of 50% indicate incomplete/missing assignments.

Scores of 50% earned at the final will be averaged with scores earned at midterm.
