

SOME TEACHERS DON'T ALLOW E-DEVICE USE. SOME DO. YOUR SCHOOL'S POLICY SUPPORTS BOTH.

Photographing, recording, posting or publishing persons' words or images without the subject's permission is a violation of school policy, and in some cases, illegal. **Personal electronic devices must be turned "OFF" and stored out of sight during classes.** Appropriate device use is permitted before and after school, during passing periods, during FLEX, and during lunch. **A staff member can choose to grant students permission to use their devices during a class under their supervision and/or in compliance with a classroom policy.*** Staff have the authority to confiscate students' devices when their use is not in compliance with class, school, or district policy. Tumwater School District is not liable or responsible for loss or damage of devices pursuant to this policy. When a student violates school policy, a warning may also be issued, followed by parent contact. Repeat offenses may result in a discipline referral. ***As a general rule, before a student enters a classroom, all personal electronic devices should be put away, turned off, and not taken out or heard until the class is dismissed.*** — Student Handbook

The ART ROOM'S POLICY on Personal Electronic Devices (phones, laptops, Chromebooks®, toys, games, etc.)

- ❖ Silent use of personal electronic devices is **permitted** during class time and is intended for **course-related purposes**.
- ❖ Users are **appropriate** and **considerate**. They use earphones/headphones/splitters and do not cause disruptions.
- ❖ Users are expected to maintain a current semester grade of **60%** or higher.

Violations and abuses are recorded, issued consequences, reported to families and/or referred to administration.
