

Amendments 2 thru 10

The Rest of the Bill of Rights

2nd Amendment

- A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.
- *DC v. Heller* court case
- Individuals do have a right to bear arms, not just the militia

3rd Amendment

- Quartering of troops is forbidden
- Unless the gov't goes to a federal judge and has the judge declare a nat'l emergency



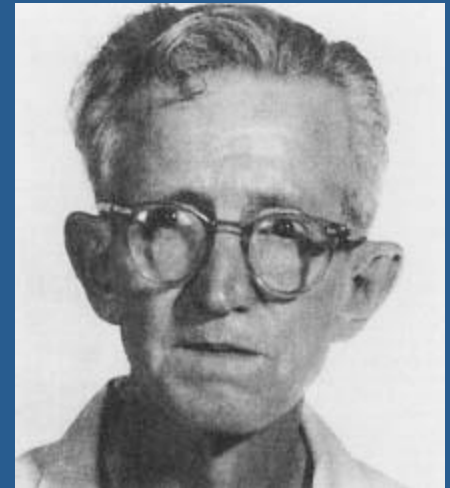
4th Amendment

- Protection against unreasonable searches and seizures
- Warrants issued based upon probable cause
- The exclusionary rule = evidence gained improperly must be thrown out

5th Amendment

- Indictment by a “Grand Jury”
- Right to remain silent
- Double Jeopardy
- Due Process
- Eminent Domain
- *Miranda v. Arizona (1966)*
- The police must read you your rights

6th Amendment



- Speedy and public trial
- Impartial jury of your peers
- Know the charges brought against you
- Question witnesses and call witnesses on your behalf
- Right to a lawyer
- *Gideon v. Wainwright*

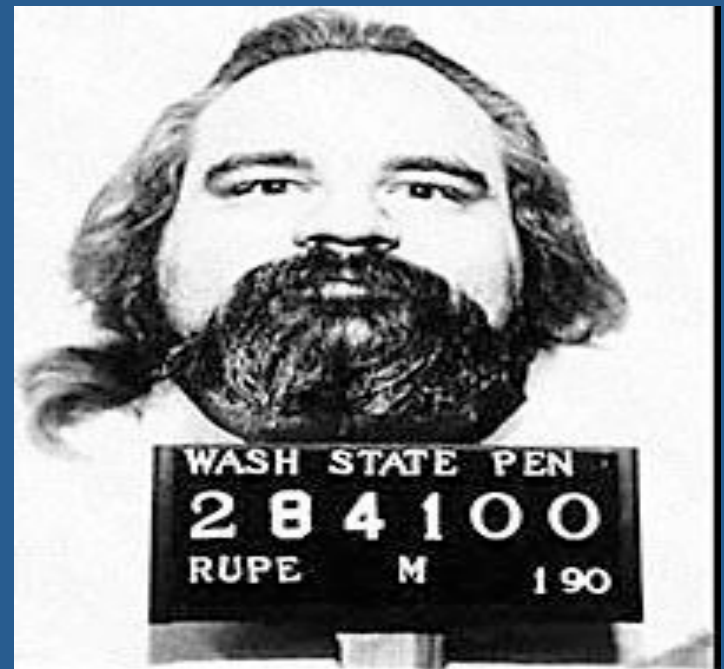
7th Amendment

- Civil suits of more than \$20, you can request a jury trial



8th Amendment

- No excessive bail or fines
- Punishment must fit the crime
- No cruel or unusual punishment
- Mitchell Rupe Case
