- Applicants will be judged on citizenship, academic achievement and financial need.

### DEADLINE

- **Must be postmarked by March 10, 2023**

- Official transcripts required
- No test scores are required if they aren't required at the institutions you applied to.

- Plan to attend an accredited and approved four-year institution within the United States or affiliated with a United States-based college or university
- Demonstrate leadership potential and dedication to community service
- If you have them, submit official SAT or ACT scores from junior or senior year
- Not possess a degree from, or be enrolled in, a 2- or 4-year college when applying
