Satellite Food Bank System

Thurston County Food Bank works in Partnership with these additional locations to make it easier for you to get groceries. The Emergency Food Assistance Program

TEFAP is federal commodities which offers additional commodity food on a first come first served basis, to those who meet income guidelines. It is available regularly at our main Client Services Center in downtown Olympia.

CSFP Program for Seniors

This case-managed federal program targets seniors over the age of 60. The amount of food is consistent from month to month and offered in addition to TEFAP and our basic food service. Participants receive a 40lb box of food once per month the box contains the following items:

- Cheese
