President Jay Wood called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. He reviewed the process for public comment and suggestion cards.

Introduction of New Building Administrators: John Bash shared that building administrators will be introducing their new administrators. THS Principal Jeff Broome introduced new Assistant Principal Lisa Perreira. TMS Principal Jon Wilcox introduced Nick Reykdal, new assistant principal. EOE Principal Patty Kilmer introduced Elliott Hedin as new Assistant Principal for East Olympia and Black Lake (this is a new role for Elliott). MTS Principal Shannon Leatherwood introduced new Assistant Principal Kyle Grunenfelder (he attended MTS and most recently taught there, too). BHHS Principal Dave Myers introduced Cathy McNamara as the new assistant principal (coming from her role as assistant principal at TMS).

Special Recognition

Public School Employees Stuff the Bus Event and TOGETHER! Back to Basics Immunization & Sports Physical Event: Kim Howard introduced Steve Yale who has been the coordinator of the Stuff the Bus event for the past three years. Jeff Chase is a bus driver and drives the bus in the 4th of July Parade, helps at each event and works the entire day. The Back to Basics event was the first one this year. The idea came from Jennifer Gould. She worked tirelessly on this event and coordinated all the details. Tanya Greenfield was the right hand working with Jennifer. On behalf of the Board, Janine Ward presented them with certificates of appreciation.

Approval of Minutes

Rita Luce/Bob Barclift, Moved/Seconded (M.S.), to approve the minutes from the August 13, 2015 meeting as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Site Report from Support Services Supervisors

<u>Buildings & Grounds</u>: Ken Ames shared that staff have been busy getting the schools ready for September. He shared about the move of preschool to New Market and the added kindergarten classrooms at MTS. They have been holding safety meetings and there is a new global standard for MSDS, so they have been working on updating the MSDS books at each site. Resource conservation has been a focus for the last several years. We've been doing well and maintaining the reductions that we have accomplished in the past.

- Food Services: Bob Gibson thanked Ken's crew for their work on refrigeration inspections and repairs. The last four years there have been quite a few required changes to menus more fruits and vegetables for lunch, breakfast implementing offer vs. serve with requirement to have fruit or vegetables, reduced sodium, mandatory training for all food services employees for professional standards, changes to vending machines, ala carte sales and school nutrition policies. The number of lunches we served has gone down in the last two years by approximately 100 per day and breakfasts served are down approximately 11 per day. He is excited about a new menu system Nutrislice. It has web access and mobile apps available.
- Transportation: Rhonda Morton reviewed that our average last year was transporting 5,222 students and 223 special education students per day. Our buses traveled over 1 million miles. She reviewed the process they are going to use to check the bus to make sure it's empty. A bus accident/incident report from last year was presented. The new online Transfinder system for building secretaries to search for a student. Also, a bus route finder Infofinder I has been implemented, where you can type in your address and it shows you where your bus stop is in comparison to your house, which schools you are zoned to attend and what time the bus comes.

Superintendent's Report

- Smarter Balanced Test Results: Tara Richerson shared that the scores give us a new baseline for school performance in English/language arts and mathematics. We are still reflecting on and learning about what the scores mean for our programs. She reviewed the ELA and mathematics results for our schools and showed that all grades outperformed the state at all grade levels and subjects. We did not experience the significant drop in scores that were predicted by the field test. The technology worked well and she thanked the technology staff, led by Dan Reich, who made the technology work so well. Some of the challenges we face low participation rates by 11th grade students were the critical factor in moving high schools further into school improvement, students from low-income families and special education students experience the largest gaps in performance compared to their peers, and score reports have been much later than in previous years.
- ➤ <u>Boards of Distinction Application Discussion</u>: John reviewed a draft of the application and thanked the District Leadership Team for their input into this draft application. He asked Board members to review and comment. A final will be brought to the September 10th meeting for Board signatures.
- Superintendent Remarks: John shared that the DLT members are going to be attending/visiting each to the school's open houses/socials. Tumwater hosted the ESD 113 Board of Directors meeting last week. John and Chris shared a Tumwater SD update at the meeting. Tumwater U is September 1st at BHHS. John will send a reminder of the timeline. A GRUB meeting was held this week with Chris, Jeff, Dave, Tara, Mitch and two GRUB representatives to discuss what work will be done during the study year. We will bring City of Tumwater to the table now to look at what the respective responsibilities will be.
